BLACK BELT REQUIREMENTS

Working towards black belt starts as soon as you step on the mat. It is important to learn the principles of breaking balance and listening to the Japanese words. Also there is a contest element and if you haven't done contest from the start it is very tough.

Points:

Not unlike your Samurai Sam event you need to score points for 1st Dan you need 100 points this can only be earned by winning contests by Wazari (7) or Ippon (10) this sounds simple but when you add in that you are fighting others who also want their black belt this is pretty tough. There is an even tougher route if you win 2 contests by Ippon you may be given a line up 3 contests without a break ALL of which you must win by Ippon within the contest time.

Theory:

Once you have your points or line up in the bag you need to do the theory this test is from any theory you have learnt on the way from red to brown it has to be shown at an advanced level, there are also a few techniques you may need to learn in addition to you red – brown theory. The examiner grades you techniques 3, 5, 7, or 10 and you need to score 150 to pass for 1st Dan this increases for each Dan
